

Apple Pollination

Apple varieties can generally be pollinated by any other variety in the same column or in an adjacent column. Sterile pollen varieties are marked with a "T" for triploid. Sterile varieties must be pollinated by a variety that is not sterile. They cannot pollinate another variety. Crabapples can also pollinate apples as long as they bloom at the same time.
