Crassula (Jade Plant)	60 - 90 degrees	45 - 60 degrees	East, South or West	Thoroughly then allow surface to dry	Every 4 weeks May - Oct.	Spring to Fall	Anytime but no water for 10 days after. Likes to be pot bound.
Ficus Chinese Banyan	70 - 90 degrees	60 - 70 degrees	East, South, West. Avoid direct summer sun.	Plenty when growing. Allow to dry slightly in winter.	Every 2 weeks when growing. Once a month in winter.	Anytime. Cut to bottom leaf node.	Every two years. Spring is best.
Leptospermum (Australian Myrtle)	60 - 80 degrees	50 - 60 degrees	East, South, West. Avoid direct summer sun.	Never allow to dry out.	Every 2 weeks April - Nov. Every 6 weeks Dec. - March	Anytime	Move to slightly larger pot every year after a little root pruning.
Podocarpus (Buddhist Pine)	70 - 90 degrees	60 - 70 degrees	East, West window. Avoid direct summer sun.	Keep evenly moist.	Every 2 weeks April - Nov. Every 6 weeks Dec. - Mar.	Anytime	Every 2 years. Spring is best. Light root pruning.

Punica (Pomegranate)	60-90 degrees	40-50 degrees	South or West Likes Sun	Plenty when growing. Little when dormant.	Every 2 weeks Apr.-Oct. Nothing when dormant	Anytime	Every 2 years just before leaves appear in spring.
Serissa (Snow Rose)	70-90 degrees	60-70 degrees	East, South, West. Likes sun.	Thoroughly, then allow to dry a bit.	Every 2 weeks Mar.-Oct. Every 4 weeks Nov.-Feb.	Anytime	Every 2 years. Spring is best.
Ulmus (Chinese Elm)	60-90 degrees	40-50 degrees	East, South, West. Likes sun.	Thoroughly, then allow to dry out slightly	Every 2 weeks Apr-Oct Nothing when dormant.	Anytime	Every 2 years before growth begins.
